

Frankfurter Sparkasse Skylight Run

Your race info for Friday, September 4, 2026

Friday is race day: the first Frankfurter Sparkasse Skylight Run starts on the banks of the Main. Here is everything you need for the evening; you will find all updates on the event page: frankfurt-in-bewegung.de/events/skylight-run-frankfurt

SCHEDULE

18:00 Venue opens: bib pickup, sundowner, bar, DJ

19:00 Interview with world and European championship participant Johannes Frenzel (Eintracht Frankfurt)

19:30 Group warm-up

20:00 Start 10k

from 20:30 After-run party

21:30 Start 5k

22:15 Course closes

The awards ceremony takes place during the after-run party; the host will announce it in time. IRONMAN Frankfurt announcer Hartwig Thöne guides you through the evening.

GETTING THERE

Start and finish are below the Holbeinsteg bridge on the Sachsenhausen side, opposite the Städel Museum. For your navigation app: Schaumainkai 63, 60596 Frankfurt.

By train: Schweizer Platz (U1, U2, U3, U8) or tram 15/16 to Otto-Hahn-Platz, both less than a ten-minute walk. From the north side: Willy-Brandt-Platz (U1 to U5, U8) across the Untermainbrücke, or from the main station across the Holbeinsteg.

By car: there is no parking at the venue. Car parks nearby: Untermainanlage 1, Willy-Brandt-Platz 5, Walter-Kolb-Straße 16. By bike: racks along the Museumsufer, bring a lock.

YOUR BIB

Pick up your bib from 18:00 in the start/finish area, until shortly before the 5k start. Bring your registration confirmation and photo ID; if you collect for someone else, you need a written authorisation. Under 18? Bring a consent form signed by your legal guardian or come together with them. Wear the bib visibly on your front; the timing chip is built in and the bib is not transferable. The start/finish channel is for runners only, so agree on a meeting point outside with your crew.

BAG DROP

The bag drop in the start/finish area is staffed from 19:00 to 22:30. Valuables are better left at home; we accept no liability for them. There are no changing rooms or showers, come ready to run.

COURSE

One 5k loop along both banks of the Main: Sachsenhäuser Ufer, Flößerbrücke, Mainkai, Holbeinsteg. The 10k runs the loop twice. Pacers on the 10k: 40, 50 and 60 minutes. There are no start corrals, line up by pace.

The riverside path is marked and staffed with course marshals but stays open to the public. Expect pedestrians and cyclists and follow the marshals' instructions. A lead bike rides ahead of the field, a sweep rider covers the back. Private bike escorts are not allowed.

FOOD & DRINKS

Aid station at the lap point. At the finish: fruit, pretzels, cake, water, coke, electrolytes by **Dryll** and snacks by **Popcrn**, meant for everyone with a bib.

AFTER-RUN PARTY

Your first drink at the **Quarantini** bar is on us; every drink comes with or without alcohol (gin 18+). Plus DJ and photo point. Watching and celebrating are open to everyone, drinks for guests at bar prices.

MEDAL & RESULTS

You get your medal right behind the finish line, and a **Frankfurter Sparkasse** water bottle is waiting for you there. Your time and your digital certificate are available right afterwards via the event page.

The Malteser medical service is stationed at the Holbeinsteg; if you need help, talk to the course team. You take part at your own responsibility; if you have health concerns, talk to your doctor first. Mobile toilets are in the start/finish area. The weather forecast for Friday currently looks very good; we run even in rain, and if anything changes at short notice, we let you know by mail and on Instagram. Please use the bins along the course and at the finish.

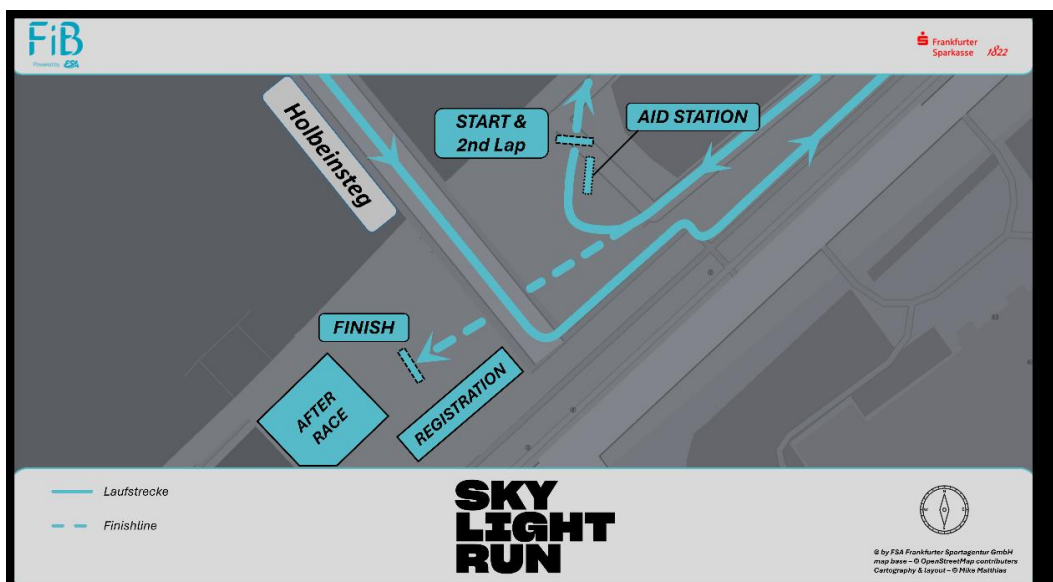
